

**Addendum to the
Memorandum of Understanding
between
Participating UN Organizations,
and
the UNDP Multi-Partner Trust Fund Office
regarding the Operational Aspects of a
UN Multi-Partner Human Security Trust Fund
For the Aral Sea Region in Uzbekistan**

WHEREAS, the Participating United Nations Organizations signing this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to collectively as the “Participating UN Organizations”) signing this Memorandum of Understanding have developed a **UN Multi-Partner Human Security Trust Fund For the Aral Sea Region in Uzbekistan** (hereinafter referred to as the “Fund”) starting on **12 November 2018** and ending on **31 December 2023** (hereinafter “End Date”), as may be amended from time to time, as part of the Government of Uzbekistan (hereinafter referred to as the “Host Government”), as more fully described in the Terms of Reference of the Multi-Donor Trust Fund dated **12 November 2018** (hereinafter referred to as the “TOR”), a copy of which is attached hereto as ANNEX A, and have agreed to establish a coordination mechanism (hereinafter referred to as the “Steering Committee”) to facilitate the effective and efficient collaboration between the Participating UN Organizations for the implementation of the Fund;

WHEREAS, the Participating UN Organizations have agreed that they should adopt a coordinated approach to collaboration with donors who wish to support the implementation of the Fund and have developed a TOR to use as the basis for mobilising resources for the Fund, and have further agreed that they should offer donors the opportunity to contribute to the Fund and receive reports on the Fund through a single channel;

WHEREAS, the Participating UN Organizations have further agreed to ask the United Nations Development Programme (Which is also a Participating UN Organization in connection with this Fund) through the Multi-Partner Trust Fund Office to serve as the administrative interface between the donors and the Participating UN Organizations and for these purposes the Multi-Partner Trust Fund Office has agreed to do so in accordance with this Memorandum of Understanding; and

The Steering Committee, the Participating UN Organizations, and UNDP MPTF Office have now agreed to **extend the Fund until 31 December 2024**.

All other terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Understanding remain unchanged.
