<b>Description</b>	<p>The joint project will provide catalytic support to the Government of Chad to establish a strategy and a programmatic approach for durable solutions to internally displaced people in Chad. The project has two main objectives: a) to support the Government of Chad in developing and implementing a national strategy on solutions for IDPs, which is based on its recent national IDP law to domesticate the African Union Convention for the Protection and Assistance of IDPs in Africa as well as the interministerial decree on Durable Solutions in Chad, and will include the identification and mobilization of potential partners and resources, the development and implementation of a handover plan, and the establishment and strengthening of a monitoring and evaluation system; and b) to support the Government of Chad to implement the strategy at the local level for providing government-led durable solutions for IDPs in the Lake Province Chad, which includes local integration, relocation or voluntary return based on preferences expressed by IDPs.</p> <p>The project will be implemented by two UN agencies: UNDP and IOM, who will work under a joint programme modality and develop a specific work-plan to achieve the results and approach as set out in this proposal in support of the Government of Chad. The project will adopt a community-based approach, involving the direct participation of IDPs and host communities throughout the project cycle in the design, implementation, and monitoring of the solutions. Through targeting strategic and programmatic levels, the project aims to provide an impetus for other actors to become engaged in durable solutions for IDPs and to mobilise additional resources. The project will also integrate gender-related perspectives and goals, ensuring the participation and empowerment of women and girls, as well as the protection and promotion of their rights. 
