Based on the updates detailed in the Narrative Annual Progress Report submitted on April 3, 2024, it has been determined by the project partners that an extension of six months (no-cost extension) would provide significant and beneficial interventions for the programme, key government counterparts, and beneficiaries. This extension entails the change of project end date from August 8, 2024, to February 8, 2025, and will allows for effective implementation and completion of all programme activities.

The request for a no-cost extension is primarily due to the constraints highlighted in the Annual Progress Report, encompassing challenges in engaging with specific government counterparts and the adverse impact of the tropical cyclones Judy, Kevin, and Lola in 2023. These natural disasters resulted in temporary operational closures and shifts in government priorities, subsequently affecting the programme's plans and execution in 2023.
