	i. ii.	Audit Tool - The latest revised Draft of the UNESCO-led Draft Audit Tool on identifying stigma and discrimination practices towards persons with disabilities in TVETs is at the very final stages. The Draft revised Tool was validation by an estimated 80 Members from the multi- stakeholder from the Ad Hoc Committee Members at a blended workshop from 14-15 November 2023. The validated Draft Audit Tool was also shared with the UNPRPD Secretariat and the last stage for UNESCO is the incorporation of comments, layout, design and publishing of the Final Audit Tool. In addition, UNESCO plans to produce publications of summarized findings of results from the Audit Tool for dissemination in the 4 countries. Reasonable accommodation Guidelines for Employers development process by ILO has begun with an initial validation of the Zimbabwe situation analysis of stigma and discrimination of persons with disabilities of workers and existing Reasonable Accommodation. The first exercise took place early December 2023. Additional time is still required by ILO to conclude this first stage which is crucial informs the broad Reasonable Accommodation Guidelines. Please note that ILO faced challenges and delays in identifying the suitable Contractor to develop the Tool. ILO had undertaken the recruitment process twice.
