2. Reason revision is being requested

Project revision reason **Programme revision 1: Change of implementing agency for Component 1 from UNDP to UNMAS.**

Due to administrative reasons UNDP has opted to handover Component 1 of the proposal to UNMAS, which is the activity "Provision of Principal Mine Action Advisor to the UN RCO, to support the UN efforts to strengthen national capacities and to facilitate UN coherence on mine action at the community level".

The United Nations Mine Action Service (UNMAS) has stepped in to ensure the mentioned activity is fully implemented, i.e. the only modification is the replacement of UNDP by UNMAS as implementing partner for Component 1.

The UCRF Steering Committee has approved this change.

Programme revision 2: Extension of programme duration

In order to ensure the implementation of the Component 1, i.e. functioning of the Principal Mine Action Advisor to the UN RCO, now to be ensured by UNMAS, it is proposed to extend the implementation of the project until 31 December 2024.

Furthermore, for Component 2, extension is needed to cover for some unforeseen implementation delays.

While the detailed design of the building with storage shelving and administration facilities are already implemented and are well on track to be completed by the anticipated deadline of 11 September 2024, UNOPS has experienced a few delays in ensuring the fencing of the site due to multiple reasons, including conscription issues affecting local personnel/contractors, power shortages due to ongoing attacks on energy infrastructure and delays in the delivery of CCTV surveillance cameras. Indicative anticipated completion date is 01 November 2024.

Programme revision 3: Minor reallocation of the budget within Component 2.

In order to ensure proper implementation considering no cost extension of the project, UNOPS proposes minor budget reallocation from savings under budget lines Contractual services and Travel to budget lines Staff and other personnel and General and Operating costs.
