Programme activities:

- (a) Organised the Development Partners Emergency Group meeting bringing together UN agencies, CDC, DFID, PHE and NGOs to review plans for implementing the Inter-Agency Rapid Response (IA-RR) plan. The Development Partners Emergency Group agreed that the IA-RR Technical Team should convene update the contact lists for incident management and plan the simulation of the plan.
- (b) Chaired the IA-RR Technical Team meeting which agree to review all functional areas and responsibilities of the IA-RR plan to ensure it conforms to current needs and recognises capacity and funding situation prevailing now.
- (c) Sent out the contact lists to functional leads to update them with current incident managers and focal points.
- (d) Participated in weekly Emergency Preparedness, Response and Resilience Group meetings to monitor the EVD situation and make response plans.
- (e) Coordinated the proposal development for MPTF funding to support survivors.
- (f) Continued analysis of the needs and resources available for survivors with the agencies and partners supporting the Comprehensive Programme for Support to EVD Survivors (CPES).

Operational activities:

Fire extinguishers and smoke detectors were installed in the office.
