Programme activities:

- (a) Assisted the Resident coordinator (RC) to engage with partners in the various coordination priorities with regard to preparedness and support to survivors such as the UNCT Core Group meeting, NGO Steering Committee meeting, and discussions between the UK Military Medical recce unit and UN agencies on how to coordinate and share experiences during the UK Military Medical exercise to learn how to respond better to health emergencies planned in June 2016 in Sierra Leone.
- (b) Participated in weekly Emergency Preparedness, Response and Resilience Group meetings to monitor the EVD situation and make response plans.
- (c) Reviewed past and ongoing UNCT support for survivors and prepared a presentation used recently at the World Bank-IMF Spring Meetings in Washington D.C.
- (d) Commenced analysis of the needs and resources available for survivors with the agencies and partners supporting the Comprehensive Programme for Support to EVD Survivors (CPES).

Operational activities:

- All the 3 staff of the unit commenced work and have taken the vital administrative and security procedures to ensure they work without difficulties.
- > Office set up is almost complete and some additional furniture, fire safety and security equipment have been procured and should be delivered in the coming weeks. Air conditioning has been installed.
