With regards to Housing Land and property, there is need to conduct an in-depth study (location specific) on Housing Land and Property issues in order to establish a solid base for which appropriate interventions can be developed. Protection against forced evictions remains a key priority. A monitoring system that primarily looks at pre-evcition and evictions monitoring with an intended preventive nature was put in place by UNHCR with the support of the Office of the UN Special Rapporteur on the humrights of IDPs in September 2013. Given the prevalence of forced evictions, monitoring and intervention and response capacity will be expanded through the Protection Cluster.
