#### NARRATIVE SUMMARY

#### Overview

UNIFEM seeks funding from the UN Action Multi-Donor Trust Fund on behalf of the UN Action Secretariat to financially support the Secretariat for a period of one year to commence on 1 January 2010.

UN Action's Secretariat is comprised of a Coordinator (P-5), Advocacy & Women's Rights Officer (P-3) and a Programme Assistant (ALD-1). The Secretariat provides administrative and technical support to the UN Action network of Focal Points and Steering Committee members in implementing its programmatic and operational objectives outlined in the UN Action Strategic Framework. UN Action Secretariat staff members are administered under UNIFEM staff contracts and are subject to the UNDP/UNIFEM rules and regulations. UNIFEM HQ (New York) hosts the Advocacy & Women's Rights Officer and the Programme Assistant while OHCHR HQ (Geneva) hosts the Coordinator. This proposal covers the salaries of the UN Action Secretariat plus expenses.

### Staffing

The below table provides the pro-forma rates for staffing each UN Action Secretariat staff member. Each amount incorporates salary, entitlements and all other related "costs to company" incurred by the Organization in supporting each staff member.

In addition, UNIFEM HQ charges \$1,100 per month for each office space occupied in New York. For a one year period, this totals \$26,400 for two staff members (P-3 and ALD-1). OHCHR provides office space, without charge, for the Coordinator as part of its contribution to the UN Action network.

A small miscellaneous budget of \$5,000 is requested to cover the costs of office supplies, equipment and tele-communication for staff in both New York and Geneva.

#### Contracts

Since its inception, the UN Action website has been maintained by a Brazilian-based IT firm named LuccaCo. It is anticipated that LuccaCo's contract will be renewed for a one-year period when its current contract expires in March 2010. Based upon the 2009-10 contract, it is expected that the 2010-11 contract will cost approximately \$35,000.

As UN Action is comprised of 12 UN system entities, its website and advocacy products are jointly owned. Therefore, it is envisioned that funding for the website will continue to be provided through the UN Action MDTF. UNIFEM serves as one of the lead entities in developing the UN Action advocacy strategy and, therefore, is well-positioned to carry out the terms of such contract.

## Explanation of funds requested by UN Action MDTF

The total programme budget amounts to US \$720,137 which includes staffing, travel and contract costs.



An additional 7%, or \$50,410, is required to cover the indirect support costs to UNIFEM. Therefore, the grand total requested by UNIFEM to the MDTF is \$770,547.
