2. Reason revision is being requested:

- Since the start of the project, 2 cyclones have hit three project countries Fiji, Vanuatu and Tonga. The engagement of government in cyclone response and recovery caused some delays in project activities early in the year. This event was highlighted in the Risk Management Matrix and classified as high.
- 2. COVID-19 is having a prolonged impact in all pacific countries with Fiji facing its second wave triggering additional challenges to organizing activities due to restricted movement and gatherings. This event was highlighted in the Risk Management Matrix and classified as high.
- 3. Missions have not been possible to project countries to assess partner capacities in light of COVID19, seek agreement on implementation of activities, participate actively in activities and conduct monitoring. This has resulted in changing of implementing partners to ensure project activities are delivered effectively.



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- 4. With no missions, travel budget lines have been underspent. There is a need to re-allocate these funds to activity lines under the same outputs, to strengthen and scale existing activities and for new activities that will add value to the output. The scaling of activities and new value adding activities will need additional time to implement.
- 5. The Project Coordinator and Assistant were only recruited in March 2021. This has delayed some management functions of the project.

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- 6. IFAD funds came through in July 2021. This has delayed planned project activities for the agriculture beneficiaries/outputs.
- 7. The beneficiaries (agriculture and creatives), have their major sales months are December and January. Evidence also shows that these are the major months that remittance spike. Therefore, it will take February/March to document some good impact (eg. increase in sales/income, etc), and the project extension will allow this to happen.
