Le projet Appui à la coordination et au suivi des projets du Fonds de Consolidation de la Paix au Burkina Faso est mis en place pour soutenir les dispositifs de gouvernance, de coordination et de suivi-évaluation du portefeuille PBF. Tout le staff du Secrétariat est en place et installé au sein de la Direction Générale du Développement Territorial (DGDT), du Ministère de l'Économie, des Finances et de la Prospective. Le staff du PBF forme ainsi un Secrétariat conjoint avec l'équipe de Coordination du Programme d'Urgence pour le Sahel au Burkina Faso (PUS-BF). Le portefeuille actif au premier semestre 2022 du PBF au Burkina Faso comprend 13 projets pour un budget total de 22 543 724 \$. Ces projets interviennent dans 10 régions, précisément dans 48 Communes. Le taux d'exécution du budget global est de 52% au 31 mai 2022.

Le premier semestre 2022 est marqué par le coup d'Etat militaire survenu au Burkina Faso le 24 janvier 2022. Le Gouvernement et l'Assemblée nationale ont été dissous et un Gouvernement de transition a été mis en place le 5 mars 2022. Les Conseils communaux ont également été dissous et remplacés par des « délégations spéciales » supervisées par les Préfets. Cette situation d'exception, aggravée par une insécurité persistante a obligé les Nations Unies à effectuer un exercice de « Programme criticality » et suspendre partiellement certaines activités programmatiques, à l'exception de l'assistance humanitaire et l'appui direct aux communautés à travers les organisations de la société civile. Dans ces conditions, la mise en œuvre des projets PBF a connu un ralentissement important, voire une suspension de certains projets tels que la Réforme du Secteur de la Sécurité (RSS) et l'Appui au processus de réconciliation nationale.

En matière de coordination, le Secrétariat a organisé plusieurs rencontres avec les agences et ONG récipiendaires pour examiner la situation des différents projets selon les orientations du Programme criticality. Les agences ont été encouragées à poursuivre la mise en œuvre des activités communautaires suivant les directives de UNCT. Au niveau des projets transfrontaliers, plusieurs réunions virtuelles ont été organisées avec le Mali, le Niger, le Benin et le Togo.

Le Secrétariat a assuré le suivi de quatre évaluations finales des projets: PBF/IRF-315 Appui à la mobilisation des jeunes, acteurs de la cohésion sociale et la paix dans les régions du Centre Nord et du Sahel ; PBF/BFA/A-1 Appui à la gestion pacifique des conflits locaux dans les régions du Sahel et du Nord ; PBF/IRF-331 Appui à la Co-consolidation de la paix et de la cohésion sociale dans le Centre-Nord ; PBF/IRF-353 Promotion d'une transhumance pacifique dans la région du Liptako-Gourma (Mali, Niger, Burkina).

Une enquête de perception nationale sur la paix et la réconciliation nationale a été réalisée et les résultats préliminaires sont disponibles.

Trois missions de suivi sur le terrain et les rencontres bilatérales ont permis de surmonter les difficultés spécifiques des différents projets, notamment le changement de localité à cause de l'insécurité, l'orientation des OSC partenaires etc. Au cours des rencontres bilatérales, le Secrétariat a fait des rappels sur les règles de gestion des projets PBF aux agences et ONG récipiendaires.

Les missions d'appui ont également été organisées dans les régions de l'Est, des Hauts Bassins, des Cascades et du Sud-Ouest pour appuyer les équipes des agences et leurs partenaires locaux de mise en œuvre.

Tous les rapports du 1er semestre 2022 des 13 projets actifs sont revus par le Secrétariat avant de les mettre en ligne sur le Gateway.

Enfin le Secrétariat a joué un rôle important dans le processus de sélection des idées des projets et l'élaboration des notes conceptuelles en réponse à l'appel à proposition GYPI du PBF.
