2. Reason revision is being requested:

From January till late May, UNICEF conducted an overall assessment for GBVIMS country rollout together with the global GBVIMS technical team. For 4.5 months UNICEF has negotiated the component of content development with 12 CSOs under the Coalition and has already concluded the negotiations at implementation detail level, reaching the point of signing the partnership agreement. UNICEF has also negotiated with IMIN LLC, the owner of GBV prevention and protection mobile app SafeYOU, to become an open source and register as a global digital public good, which has been already granted in July.

One of the project targets on the number of organizations that have agreed to the strategy for roll-out of tech operated GBVIMS with fully functional Primero/GBVIMS+ systems has been reduce from 10 to 3 (Output indicator 1.3.1), as per actual discussions, assessment of the organizational capacity and other criteria, as well as due to a lengthy approval process. Hence, the extension is requested to be able to administer the quality roll-out.



COVID 19 pandemic, regional military conflict in conjunction with the conflict in and around Nagorno Karabakh led the country into a political instability which resulted in snap parliamentary elections in June 2021. Due to the new government appointments and change of partners in the government counterparts, implementation of UNIDO activities got delayed, in particular, the establishment of the Grant Fund jointly with Investment Support Center. To avoid any risk associated with the Grant Fund, its establishment was suspended until late August 2021, not before the formation of the new Government and reassurance of the continuation of previously initiated programs addressing economic impact of COVID-19.
