There is no intended variation in programme Outcomes or Outputs. However, for the ultimate result 'strengthened services for the elimination of violence against women with disabilities, following evidence-based interventions and changed attitudes and behaviour of rights holders and duty bearers', and based on the additional feedback provided by the UNPRPD Technical Secretariat and implementing entities, the activities will be slightly adjusted as follows:

Activity 1: Strengthen the WDSI tool and Ethical guidance (preferably in one document)
by leveraging additional feedback from UNPRPD TS and implementing entities. The
unified and simplified document can be used as a practical resource by OPDs and

- governments. UNPRPD to share suggestions on how the component around assessing women's experiences in accessing GBV services can be further strengthened.
- Activity 2: UNDP and UN Women will identify one participating country based on the data that is already available to conduct validation consultation with policymakers, OPDs, women with disabilities and other stakeholders around the GBV services that are available to women with disabilities. The outcome of such a consultation would be specific recommendations for policymakers on how services and systems can be further improved.
- Activity 3: Based on the outcomes of the consultation and the findings from the participating countries, UN Women and UNDP will develop a set of policy recommendations for improving GBV service delivery for women with disabilities, including by addressing barriers created by stigma and discrimination within service delivery.
- Activity 4: Promote the project findings including recommendations in pilot/project countries for greater engagements of relevant national/cross-regional stakeholders.

3.	Reason revision is being requested.

- 3.1 Please indicate the reason for the revision.
- The project is behind schedule by 3 months.
- Protracted delays to fieldwork were caused by COVID-19, the impact of the war in Ukraine on Moldova, and severe flooding in Pakistan before field testing was due to start.
- Additionally, as project implementation gained momentum in the 1st quarter of 2022, it became quickly apparent that the two arms could not progress simultaneously as it was initially planned. Consequently, COs moved further with measurement and were not able to focus equally on intervention. There is also reduced correlation between the Interventions and results from Measurement or the produced tool. Positive responses to the surveys implied many people were willing to take part to provide data.
- Gender-based violence and the intersectionality between gender and disability is a relatively new and complex area of intervention for OPDs who have initially focused more on education, health, or employment etc. Therefore, a lot of extra support and clarity was needed to provide to implementers. This took additional time and efforts including required corresponding processes.

Outputs will remain as planned:

<u>OUTCOME 1</u>: Drivers and impacts of stigma and discrimination against women and girls with disabilities identified and reflected in policies, frameworks and services aimed at the elimination of violence against women and girls.

Output 1.1: Stigma and discrimination against women with disabilities is acknowledged and addressed by local stakeholders.

Output 1.2: Advocacy is conducted at global level to develop a comprehensive tool against stigma discrimination against women with disabilities (based PLHIV Stigma Index model).

Output 1.3: Evidence on behavioural change to reduce sigma and discrimination towards women and girls with disabilities is collected and disseminated.

Explanation: Field testing and raw data reports that were to be received by end of 2022 have since delayed. We are likely to have them, and their final analysis availed by end of March 2023 meaning a 3-month delay. Consequently, webinars to discuss and share reports among countries and with partners and compilation of end of mission report will delay by a similar or further lengthened period.

<u>OUTCOME 2:</u> Reduction in prejudicial attitudes and discriminatory behaviour towards women and girls with disabilities.

Output 2.1: Mapping exercises to identify barriers in countries completed.

Output 2.2: Behavioural interventions designed to address barriers identified in 2.1.

Output 2.3: Learning across the multi-country programmes gathered to assess impact of pilot interventions.

Explanation: Intervention reports were to be received from Country programmes by end of November 2022. However, that has since delayed with all reports and finally analysis likely to be completed in March 2023 implying a 3-month delay. Consequently, webinars to discuss and share reports among countries and with partners and compilation of end of mission report will delay by a similar or further lengthened period. There is also the concern of coordination between the results of the Measures and Interventions produced from countries.
